- Formulate match targets, objectives based on analysis, long term development plan and academy philosophy.
- Influence players, coaches, and team staff in relation to the match
- Advice about the long-term development plan
- Execute the plan according to level of the National Teams, Prince Ali Centres, Girls Grassroots activities Give leadership to coaches and staff within the Girls/Woman National Teams, Prince Ali Centres
- Personal meetings with staff and players.
- Give master classes.
- Show and share knowledge with players and coaches.
- Stimulate personal development of coaches and player.
